As of the beginning of Term 2, there will be a slight increase in the fees for children attending Before -School Care, After-School Care and/or Vacation Care/Pupil Free Days. These changes are <u>before</u> the Child Care Subsidy is applied and are as follows:



Care Type	Fee per session	Fee change after Max. Child Care Subsidy applied
Before School Care	\$18.50	\$0.10
After School Care	\$23.50	\$0.29
Vacation Care	\$62.00	\$0.39
